TRAINING AND ORIENTATION
<p>Volunteers should be prepared to commit to this role for an extended period of time. Our Reception & Boutique volunteers will be expected to possess basic knowledge of the current exhibitions and programs at the Douglas Family Art Centre, as well as the artists and artisans represented in the Art Centre Boutique.</p> <p>Initial Training: All new volunteers will do additional short shifts each week for the first month for on the spot training from staff and seasoned volunteers where they will receive specialized point of sale training.</p> <p>Trial Period: All new volunteers will be on a probationary period for three months. At the end of the three months, their role will be reviewed by the Art Centre Programmer and The Muse Director, at which point, both parties will assess if the role is a good fit for both parties.</p>

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Greeting all visitors of the Douglas Family Art Centre ensuring that they feel welcome.
- Providing guests with overviews of current exhibitions and upcoming programs.
- Answering any questions guests may have regarding exhibitions, programs, or boutique products.
- Maintaining general knowledge of the artists represented in the boutique.
- Unpacking, receiving, pricing, and restocking of boutique merchandise.
- Performing other administrative duties as needed.
- Completing special projects as assigned by the Art Centre Programmer or Curator.

POSITION QUALIFICATIONS

- Excellent customer service skills.
- Ability to communicate effectively with various types of gallery visitors including children, young adults, seniors, visitors with special needs, and those whose first language is not English.
- A passion for art and the ability to convey that enthusiasm in an engaging and professional manner.
- A willingness to learn about the various exhibitions and programs presented at the Douglas Family Art Centre, as well as the artists and artisans stocked in the Boutique.
- Ability to stand for extended periods of time and perform occasional heavy lifting.
- Competency in working with computers.
